



Value Based Doctor of Business Administration Scholarships

About the Value-Based Taught Doctor of Business Administration Scholarship

Full fee scholarships are available for students studying on the taught Doctor of Business Administration (DBA) in Swansea University's School of Management. Scholarships are funded by the Welsh Government's Intensive Learning Academy programme. To be eligible to apply applicants need to be employed in social care, health or the third sector in Wales. Further detail on eligibility is given below. Please note this is a part time programme.

The Value-Based Research Scholarship's panel would like to receive innovative and creative proposals which align to achieving the outcomes of <u>a Healthier Wales</u>

Value-Based Doctor of Business Administration Scholarship Award Process

- 1. Students need to meet the entry requirements for the DBA programme to apply for a scholarship. Students can apply for a Scholarship prior to applying for a place on the DBA programme.
- 2. Students should complete the Swansea University Application for Research Scholarship within the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences below. In their personal statement they should address the points below. **The deadline for applications is Wednesday 19 July 2023.**
- 3. Please ensure all supporting documents, including this scholarship application form are attached to your course application.
- 4. The scholarship application process is competitive and based on the information supplied by the applicant and their employer. Students should demonstrate how their research proposal will
 - help achieve the outcomes of a Healthier Wales;
 - add value to their organisation; and
 - enhance outcomes for service users, patients or community they work with.
- 5. The panel will also consider the applicants presentation at interview, their CV and previous academic achievement.
- 6. Applicants for the VBDBA scholarship will be invited to an interview with the VBDBA panel during **July/August 2023.** These may be online or in person.
- 7. The VBDBA panel will include Dr Simon Brooks, the Programme Director of the DBA Programme, Professor Hamish Laing the Value-Based Health and Care Independent Learning Academy Lead and a relevant academic depending upon the subject area proposed by the applicant.
- 8. The VBDBA Scholarship panel will inform applicants of the outcome of their application no later than 31 August 2023. All applicants will get feedback from the panel.
- 9. Any applicants who require feedback following the decision of the panel should contact the chair of the panel for further feedback
- 10. Students who are unsuccessful in their application for funding can still apply for a place on the DBA programme

Terms and Conditions for Swansea University Research VBDBA Scholarships

- 1. Value-Based DBA Scholarships are only available for new research students undertaking the part-time DBA programme at the School of Management, Swansea University;
- 2. VBDBA Scholarships covers the full home DBA tuition fee set by Swansea University
- 3. The scholarship will be set against the tuition fees and candidates cannot receive these directly;
- 4. The VBDBA Scholarship **does not** include a stipend;
- 5. VBDBA Scholarships are only available to students who;
 - are currently working with/for the National Health Service, in Health Care, Social Care or the Voluntary Sector in Wales;
 - have confirmation of support signed by their employer
 - are a UK national or have 'settled status' (that means no restrictions on how long applicants can stay in the UK);
 - are living in the UK and Islands for the three years prior to the first day of the first academic year of your course.
 OR
 - are an EU national (excluding England, Scotland and Northern Ireland) and living in the European Economic Area (EEA) or Switzerland for the past three years.
- 6. Research Scholarships are awarded for one year in the first instance. They are renewable for a further period of up to three years to cover the minimum candidature period, subject to satisfactory progress;
- 7. Scholarships offered in the spring of 2021 are valid to start the programme in the 2021-22 Academic Year; deferral of the award to a later academic session is not permitted;
- 8. To qualify for the award, students must enrol no later than 30th of September 2023;
- 9. Research Scholarships are not transferable;
- 10. Recipients of scholarships are not permitted to withdraw from, or transfer from the DBA programme, save in exceptional circumstances and subject to the approval of the Postgraduate Research Academic Board. Failure to observe this regulation may result in student becoming liable to repay fees already paid on behalf of the student;
- 11. In addition to any College based or external advertising, VBDBA Scholarships must be advertised through the central University webpages for scholarships and bursaries.

a. Employment

- 12. Recipients of scholarships are expected to actively engage and participate in University and College based postgraduate activity, including, for example, postgraduate training, poster competitions, seminars and postgraduate conferences. They may also be asked to cooperate in promoting Swansea University research programmes to new students.
- 13. If a recipient of a scholarship is absent for more than thirteen (13) weeks in an academic year, then the student will be required to suspend their study
- 14. On return to study, after suspension due to a medical condition, the student must be certified by his/her General Practitioner as fit to resume study;
- 15. Total periods of suspension must not exceed twelve (12) months during the lifetime of the award (except as noted in 22 below). If a suspension exceeds twelve (12) months, the scholarship will be terminated;

a. Termination of award

- 16. Swansea University may terminate a scholarship for the following circumstances:
 - a. There is lack of academic progress;
 - b. There is a loss of contact between the student and the University;
 - c. The student is in breach of any of the terms and conditions noted above.
