

# Bright Futures Scholarship – Terms and Conditions

1. Award of the Bright Futures Scholarship is by application only. Successful candidates will be notified by The College, Swansea University.
  2. Must be classified as an overseas student for fee purposes.
  3. Must be fully self-funding your studies.
  4. Must be a national of a Non-Thrive Country (see Thrive Bursary Terms and Conditions)
  5. Eligible for students enrolling at The College, Swansea University on Foundation, International Year One, and Pre-Master's programmes commencing in September 2026.
  6. This offer excludes existing students of The College already enrolled before September 2026
  7. Students who undertake an English Language Training Service (ELTS) course will have the Bursary applied to the tuition fees of The College, Swansea University.
  8. This must be your first programme of study at The College, Swansea University.
  9. This award is valued at £2,000. Successful applicants will have this sum removed from the tuition fees quoted on their offer letter.
  10. For students undertaking a one-semester programme, the Bright Futures Scholarship will be deducted from the first semester fees.
  11. For students undertaking a two- or three-semester programme, the Bright Futures Scholarship will be deducted from the second semester fees and third semester as applicable.
  12. Applicants in receipt of this award cannot combine it with any other tuition fee award or discount provided by The College, Swansea University. Recipients can combine this award with the Accommodation Scholarship.

13. If applicants are receiving full, non-repayable sponsorship from a government organisation or another external provider, they are not eligible to receive any awards.
14. Bright Futures Scholarship recipients are reasonably expected to co-operate in The College, Swansea University marketing activities, such as providing testimonials.
15. If it is deemed necessary for a Bright Futures Scholarship holder to suspend their studies prior to starting their programme, the Bright Futures Scholarship will not be held on account and carried forward to the year of resumption of studies. The candidate will be expected to pay their personal contribution on a pro-rata basis.
16. The College, Swansea University reserves the right to make, amend, withdraw, suspend, or cancel without notice these and such other regulations as may be in force from time to time, and such decisions shall be final.
