We are pleased to announce the launch of the Little Voices Children as Researchers Network.

## Some Background

Lleisiau Bach-Little Voices (Big Lottery Funded) is the approach used by the Observatory on Human Rights of Children (Swansea and Bangor University, Wales) to empower children as researchers and advocates. It breaks new ground, going beyond involving children in adults' research. The Lleisiau Bach approach has two overarching and distinguishing features:

1. The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) used as a framework within which to select research topics, and to guide the conduct of each project.
2. The children lead the work; we do not suggest or impose research topics, methods, conclusions or recommendations.

We are aware that many of you work with children and young people in varying capacities through many engaging activities; we invite you to become part of this network in the hope that we can share our methodology with you and build a community passionate about supporting children as researchers. ## The Network

We have recently discovered a really helpful digital tool called VocalEyes that can assist us with our communications. Using VocalEyes we have set up a Children as Researchers' Network. This network will:

- **Engage** with people who are interested in supporting children as researchers
- **Facilitate** ongoing conversation between members that can help, **inspire and connect** a community of interest
- Help the Lleisiau Bach team identify 'wants and needs' from members that can **influence our work**
- Allow members to **share, rate and explore ideas** for potential children as researchers projects
- Share **News and Blog** from the Children's Legal Centre Wales [childrenslegalcentre.wales](http://childrenslegalcentre.wales)
- Share information on **events, projects and actions** to engage with





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## How to engage:

1. Go to: [vocaleyes.org](http://vocaleyes.org)
2. Click **REGISTER** (Feel free to use your work postcode if your prefer)
3. **LOGIN** in on the Dashboard, **SEARCH** for **Lleisiau Bach** (in the top black bar)
4. Click on our group: **Lleisiau Bach/Little Voices - Children as Researchers Network**
5. Open **JOIN OPTIONS** > Become a **MEMBER**
6. Click **IDEAS** and **RATE** and **COMMENT** on **ALL** the ideas
7. **ADD IDEAS** of your own for others to consider
8. Once you've finished, make sure you go to your **EMAIL INBOX** and **VALIDATE** your email address.
