Description

The Sea Trust is a non-profit community interest company, committed to studying and raising awareness of local marine wildlife. The aim of this project is to develop observation, data handling, data analysis and interpretation protocols which Seatruster could use in the future to best assist Transition Bro Gwaun, whilst acting as a stakeholder liaison between Transition Bro Gwaun and local community. Seatruster also wish to conduct scientific surveys to the standard required by Natural Resources Wales (NRW).



Results
