When will I receive my certificate and transcript?	<p>The issuing of paper degree certificates has regrettably been delayed until later in the year as University staff are currently working remotely due to Covid-19. However, the University is pleased to announce a new service that will allow you to access a digital copy of your degree certificate and your transcript via the gradintel system. If you have not already done so, you are able to activate your gradintel account via your MyUni dashboard using the Gradintel panel and following the instructions. Once your account has been activated you will have permanent access to your certificate and transcript and be able to securely share them with third parties.
