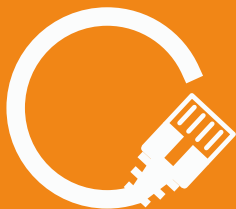


Getting online

Connecting to Optify broadband is easy – this quick guide will show you how.

Connect with Wi-Fi

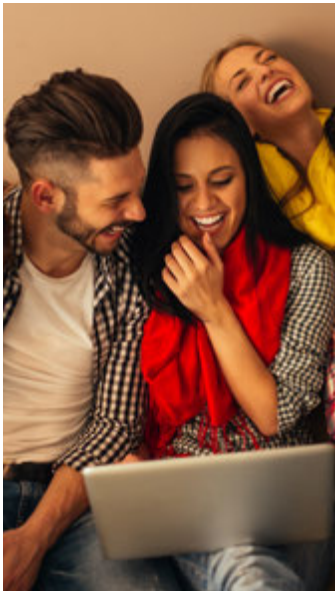
② Register for Optify
