

Thrive Bursaries (Bangladesh) – Terms and Conditions

1. Must be classified as an overseas student for fee purposes.
 2. Must be fully self-funding your studies.
 3. Must be a national of Bangladesh.
 4. Eligible for students enrolling at The College, Swansea University on Foundation, International Year One, and Pre-Master's programmes commencing in any intake between June 2026 and January 2027.
 5. This offer excludes existing students of The College already enrolled before June 2026
 6. Students who undertake an English Language Training Service (ELTS) course will have the Bursary applied to the tuition fees of The College, Swansea University.
 7. This must be your first programme of study at The College, Swansea University.
 8. For Postgraduate students studying a Pre-Master's programme, the THRIVE Bursary of £4,000 will be applied as a discount off tuition fees for the first year of study only.
 9. For Undergraduate students on Foundation or International Year One programmes:
 - o A £4,000 tuition fee discount will be applied to the initial year of study at The College, Swansea University.
 - o A £2,000 tuition fee discount will be applied for each subsequent year of undergraduate study at The College, Swansea University and at Swansea University, awarded upon successful completion of the previous year.
 - o The £2,000 tuition fee discount will not be applicable to a year in industry or year abroad.
 10. For Split CAS Foundation students from the Sylhet region of Bangladesh, the £4,000 award will be rolled-over to the second year of study. The £2,000 progression award will be awarded alongside the rolled-over THRIVE in the second year of study and will be deducted from the second semester of this year.

11. Undergraduate students must successfully complete each year with no repeat or failed modules in order to receive the following year's THRIVE Bursary progression award.

12. For students undertaking a one-semester programme, the THRIVE Bursary will be deducted from the first semester fees. Excluding students from Sylhet.

13. For students undertaking a two- or three-semester programme, the THRIVE Bursary will be deducted from the second semester fees and third semester as applicable. Excluding students from Sylhet.

14. Applicants in receipt of this award cannot combine it with any other tuition fee discounts or bursaries provided by The College, Swansea University. Recipients can combine this award with Cost of Living offers.

15. If applicants are receiving full, non-repayable sponsorship from their home country or another external provider, they are not eligible to receive any awards.

16. Postgraduate students studying a Pre-Master's programme who progress from The College to Swansea University are not eligible to receive the THRIVE Bursary a second time.

17. THRIVE Bursary holders are reasonably expected to co-operate in The College, Swansea University marketing activities, such as providing testimonials.

18. If it is deemed necessary for a THRIVE Bursary holder to suspend their studies prior to starting their programme, the THRIVE Bursary will be held on account and carried forward to the year of resumption of studies. The candidate will be expected to pay their personal contribution on a pro-rata basis.

19. The College, Swansea University reserves the right to make, amend, withdraw, suspend, or cancel without notice these and such other regulations as may be in force from time to time, and such decisions shall be final.
