Purpose: to facilitate good practice pertaining to Ethics within the College of Science in accordance with provisions set out by Swansea University Ethics Committee.

Reports to: The College of Science Research Committee, Swansea University Ethics Committee

Terms of Reference

Responsibilities on issues of ethics within the College of Science:

- 1. To ensure that appropriate ethical considerations are given to research and teaching involving living subjects, and that University guidelines are adhered to.
- 2. To update as necessary guidelines and documentation to facilitate the progress of ethics reviews, including the online Module Risk Assessment forms.
- 3. To provide information to staff and students concerning procedures for ethics review.
- 4. To ensure that each department conduct appropriate ethical assessment procedures.
- 5. To handle ethical applications that cannot be resolved at departmental level.
- 6. To enable individuals within the College of Science to raise concerns regarding ethics in research and teaching.
- 7. To refer instances of suspected ethics misconduct to the appropriate committees within the University.
- 8. To liaise with the College of Science Health and Safety Committee, and the Learning & Teaching Committee
