

Does my travel for work have an environmental impact?

Travel can be an important way of communicating our research and sharing our findings with the rest of the world. However, travel contributes to our Scope 3 emissions and costs the University more than £5 million a year. Below are some ways we can actively reduce our travel related impacts:



Carbon meter

- Check out the 'Sustainable Travel Procedure' (document coming soon) and see if you can utilise our travel hierarchy
- Consider whether you could undertake the same work using video conferencing or Zoom
- See if you can combine your work with another aspect e.g. conducting fieldwork and also visiting higher education fairs, speaking to prospective students in that area or attending a meeting on behalf of your department
- Reduce the number of people going to a single event
- Book through our travel providers so we can capture the way we travel
- Getting a taxi? Ask the company if they have low emissions vehicles available
