

# **Living On-Campus**

As a student of The College you will be invited to make the Rod Jones Hall your new home. Rod Jones is our own accommodation building located on the Bay Campus a mere 2 minute walk from our teaching building.

Living on-campus gives you easy access to all campus services including stores, restaurants, coffee shops, prayer facilities and 24 hour security. You will also benefit from beachside accommodation, easy access to our teaching facilities and a positive and welcoming campus environment.

Rooms at Rod Jones Hall start from £140 per week, visit our website for full details. All rooms in Rod Jones Hall are en-suite and come with bed, desk, bedside chest, chair, bookshelf and wardrobe. Premium rooms offer more space, a larger bed and an armchair. In addition, all rooms have broadband (WI-FI) and personal belonging insurance included in the rent.

# **English Language Support**

All international students at The College will need to demonstrate their English Language ability in order to join us. Swansea University's English Language Training Service (ELTS) offer a range of British Council Accredited options to help you achieve your goals and meet your conditions.

### **SWELT Test**

If you have an English Language Condition to meet a SWELT test may be what you are looking for. A SWELT is a great alternative to the IELTS and indeed is structured in the same way with Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking segments.

First Year	A-level or equivalent
Pre-Master's	Successful completion of a 3 year diploma equivalent to a UK HND for all subjects, with the exception of Engineering. Successful completion of a recognised UK Equivalent Bachelor Degree for Engineering Pre-Master's.
